Saturday 27th June 2015 from 10am-2.00pm in

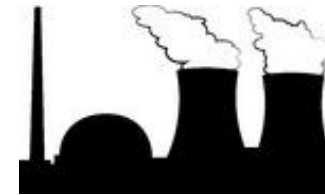
Otterhampton Village Hall which will look at feasible projects, skills, volunteers and an idea of potential project costs
