**Comwich Wharf**

I am writing to inform you of the forthcoming arrival of a large load at Comwich Wharf.

As part of our planned maintenance activities at Hinkley Point B power station, we have identified the need to secure two replacement generator transformer units. Due to their size, they will need to be transported by sea.


The barge carrying the transformers is planned to arrive at the wharf on one of the high tides during Tuesday 10 November, although this will be dependant on weather conditions. The units will then be unloaded, taken to the private road and transported to the Hinkley Point B site independently on Wednesday 11 November.

The complex operations will be carried out on our behalf by ALE (heavy lift transport company).

Due to the nature of the tidal conditions in the Bridgwater Bay and our maintenance schedule arrangements, working in the evening and during early morning may unfortunately be necessary and unavoidable in this case. We would like to apologise for any inconvenience that may be caused to local residents.
