OTTERHAMPTON PARISH COUNCIL RECEIPTS AND PAYMENTS - YEAR ENDING 31 MARCH 2017 Explanation of Differences

RECEIPTS

Overall, there is a net increase of £69478 from 2015/16 to 2016/17. This is attributable to the following:

Line 1 & 2 - Precept and Council Tax Support Grant

A net increase of £1000 re general cost increases (e.g. insurance, play area inspections, village hall grant)

Line 4 - VAT

The increase of £14216 is in line with the increase in purchases (expenditure) attracting VAT (e.g. play area)

Lines 9, 10, 11, 12 & 13

One off grant receipts

PAYMENTS

Line 14 - Annual Insurance

The increase of £316 is due to the additional premium for the enhanced play and recreation area.

Line 18a - Clerk's Salary Costs

Increase of £430 represents an extra hour per week, plus the standard increment and 1% pay award.

Lines 18b & c - compensating differences because printing costs now separated from Misc Office Expenses

Line 20 - Village Hall Rent for meetings

Reduced by £200. Previously we paid £200 Hall Hire and £200 donation. We now award 5% of our Precept as an Annual Maintenance grant (see line 36)

Line 23 - Annual Children's Play Area Inspection

The £68 in 2015/16 represents the external ROSPA inspection, not carried out in 2016/17 whilst the new play area constructed. The £120 in 2016/17 is for K.Preston carrying out weekly inspections after new play area opened.

Line 24 Play & Recreation Area - General Maintenance

Reduced by £655 re installation of enhanced play and recreation area (and hence not required)

Line 25 - Enhanced Play & Recreation Area Project

Part expenditure for play area (£44141 paid direct from Viridor to Wicksteed so will not appear as our expenditure)

Line 26 - Enhancements

a (bench) b (fence) and e (lawn mower) differences represent one-off expenditure

f (dog bins) - increase of £1029 represents additional dog bin at Brookside rd (new one by phone box and the old one moved to Brookside Rd); 2 new dog glove dispenser boxes (£215) plus dog glove bags (£224)

Lines 27, 28, 29, 30, 31 and 32

One off expenditure items

Line 35 - Defibrillator

Reduction in cost because previous year included Battery repl. and training course £160, not required in 2016/17

Line 36 - Grants - Otterhampton Village Hall Annual Maint.

New grant, agreed annual payment of 5% of the Precept (see also line 20)

Line 38 - Grants & Donations outside the parish

£100 to CAB; £100 to Mendip Transport (Slinky Bus)

Line 39 - Reserves - 2019 Election Costs

£200 in 2015/16 was paid to SDC re our proportion of 2015 Election Costs

Line 43 - VAT to be reclaimed

Increase of £18841 represents higher levels of expenditure attracting VAT (see also line 4)

Assets / Movement During The Year

- 1 The parish council has three bank accounts with Lloyd Bank; namely Current, Deposit and Reserves.
- 2 Funds will be set aside each year in Reserves to cover items such as Future Election Costs; Buoy Maintenance; Repairs to Bus Shelter; Combwich Track Maintenance; Children's Play Area Maint. The figures will be itemised both in future Budget Monitoring Statements and as identified in Annual Audit returns.
- 3 At 31 March 2017, the total value of the assets of Otterhampton Parish Council is £113952, a net increase of Capital expenditure of £90256 during the year. This net increase included writing off the old play area egpt and fence -£1630; plus purchases:- 2 x dog glove dispenser units £215; new dog bin Wharf Rd £175; 15 verge marker posts at Steart £246; new fence adjacent to road by play area £1200, an additional £1500 as amendment re Welcome Feature which was understated (should be £2500) plus the value of the enhanced play and recreation area at £88550.

Borrowings:

There were no outstanding loans to the Parish Council as at 31.3.17

Leases:

Otterhampton Parish Council has no leases.

Debts:

There were no outstanding debts to the Parish Council as at 31.3.17

Tenancies:

There were no tenancies entered into by the Parish Council.

Section 137

Section 137 of the Local Government Act enables the Parish Council to spend up to a total of £7.42 per head of the electorate for the benefit of the community on activities and projects not specifically authorised by other powers. The limit for this year was £4964 (669 x £7.42).
