Notification of Abnormal Indivisible Load (AIL) training

We are writing to inform you that during the month of September, the Avon & Somerset Constabulary (A&SC) Roads Policing Team will be delivering training to the Hinkley Point C team, in order to support future AIL movements.

As part of the training, there will be two days of practical sessions, currently planned to take place on Thursday 5th and Thursday 12th September. The exercises will be run throughout the day from the exit point of the Combwich Wharf Private Access Road along the C-182 to the entry to HPC Site at South Plaza between period 9am to 4.30pm.

During these exercises, simulated convoys of up to 6 vehicles (1 HGV and 5 times 4x4) will travel under A&SC control along the C-182, with the convoys travelling at a reduced speed. We ask for your patience whilst we participate in these exercises and ask all road users to comply with the instructions issued by the Escort Vehicles.
