Delivery of permanent equipment to Hinkley Point C

We are writing to inform you about a planned delivery into Combwich Wharf.

The delivery will contain large empty fuel tanks for our emergency generators, these are the first pieces of permanent equipment to be delivered to site via Combwich Wharf. They are known as the Emergency Diesel Generators Main Fuel Tanks.

Having obtained the necessary approval from Sedgemoor District Council, the barge delivery is currently planned to arrive on a high tide on 26th October. This will be dependent on the prevailing weather conditions.

At the wharf, the barge will be unloaded during suitable high tide times. The team will keep disruption to a minimum, however there will be some noise during unloading. Noise monitoring will be in place throughout the duration of the works. Weather permitting, the barge will depart on the first suitable high tide after unloading is complete.

The fuel tanks will then be transported to Hinkley Point C, escorted by rolling traffic management convoys along the C182. This may cause slight delays along the C182 stretch between Combwich and Site, plus the Combwich main access and egress road as the loads pass.

We apologise in advance for any inconvenience these works cause and thank you for your patience during this time.
