
HEALTH AND WELFARE

Bins are situated at Brookside Road garages; the entrance to Wharf Road (on grassed area near the defibrillator); Wharf Road (at the entrance to Combwich labs) on the Common opposite Riverview, in and around the play area, and near the OPRA pavilion adjacent to the track.

Complimentary Bus Service
